It wasn't until the 1950's that Miller-Urey introduced amino acid building blocks in RNA and DNA hypotheses; the biogenic element, phosphate, as the backbone of DNA; plus Exogenous Delivery - life-essential nutrients delivered by meteors striking the Earth.
